

Best Practices

- Occupancy shall be limited to no more than 50% of the lowest occupancy load on the certificate of occupancy of the room or facility in which the religious services are conducted.
- We will post required signage at the front entrance.
- We will sanitize areas that are normally touched.
- Six foot spacing is required.
- A thorough cleaning and disinfection of frequently contacted surfaces will be conducted prior to and following any services.
- There will be hand sanitizer at the door entrance. There will also be hand sanitizer in the hall outside the bathrooms.
- Seats will be marked with each person or family's name. We will leave every other row empty. There will also be seats marked for visitors and the speaker. Seating will be in close proximity to where you normally sit. Hymn books will be pre-placed in each location and should remain there so as to be used by the same family each Sunday.
- We will have the Emblems but will not pass them. This will be explained prior to the Lord's Supper on Sunday. Feel free to abstain if you are not comfortable with this. The offering baskets will not be passed. Instead, use the box in the rear of the Auditorium.
- The Fellowship Room will be restricted.
- We will not have Sunday School classes. All will stay in the Auditorium for the Family Bible Hour.
- The coffee station will be set up in the Narthex with one person dispensing the coffee.
- Face masks will be required.

- We will monitor the temperature of all as they enter the building.
- We will not serve lunch.
- The meeting schedule will be changed as follows:
 - 9:15 Quiet time
 - 9:30 Lord's Supper
 - 10:30 Break
 - 11:00 Family Bible Hour
 - 12:00 End of services.
